The guest speaker will be Project Manager Dan Soler. Much of the planning focus in Robbinsdale surrounds the proposed LRT station in the downtown area.

Luncheon attendees will get an up-close look at the design work surrounding the station. A final piece of the presentation will be a look at the timeline for the remaining planning work, funding discussions, and construction.
